Singular – Plural

Most nouns form the plural simply by adding *s*

Singular	Plural	Singular	Plural
dog	2 dogs	boy	# boys
cat	3 cats	girl	# girls

Nouns which end in *ss*, *sh*, or *x* usually add *es*

Singular	Plural	Singular	Plural
dress	2 dresses	fox	# foxes
wish	# wishes	box	# boxes

Nouns which end with consonant + *y* usually delete the *y* and add *ies*

Singular	Plural	Singular	Plural
city	# cities	country	# countries
family	# families	melody	# melodies

Some nouns have irregular plurals

Singular	Plural	Singular	Plural
child	# children	woman	# women
man	# men	wife	# wives

Some nouns do not change in the plural

Singular	Plural	Singular	Plural
sheep	# sheep	fish	# fish / fishes (childish)
deer	# deer	cannon	# cannon

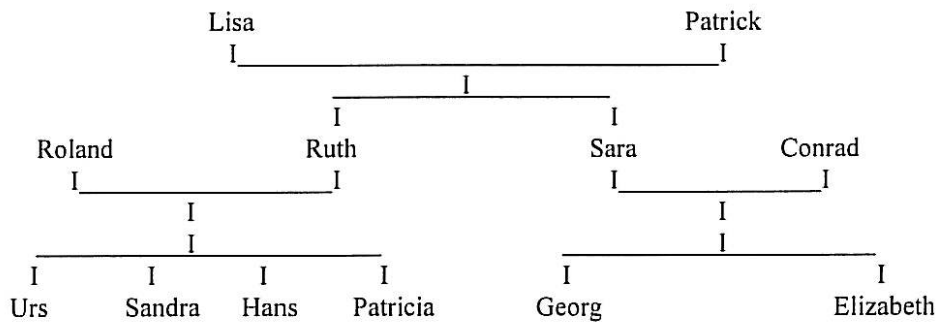
