

Biographies



Freddie Mercury (be) the lead vocalist of the British rock band, *Queen*. He was born in Stone Town, Zanzibar on 5 September 1946. He first (perform) on a stage at his school, St. Peters, with his band, the Hectics.

When he was 18, there was a revolution in Zanzibar and his family (leave) for England. He (study) Art and Graphic Design at Ealing Art College in London. In 1970 he (help) form the group, *Queen*. Later he (compose) many of *Queen's* hits, including *Bohemian Rhapsody* and *We Are the Champions*.

Freddie Mercury (die) of AIDS on 24 November 1991, in London



Bob Marley was born in Jamaica on 6 February 1945. He..... (start) his musical career in Ska music then (move) on to reggae. During the 1970s he (record) lots of songs, often with his reggae group *The Wailers*. He (release) his most famous song, *No woman no cry*, in 1975.

In July 1977 he (discover) he had cancer; then in 1980 he (collapse) during a show in New York.

A month before his death, he was awarded Jamaica's Order of Merit. He (die) in Miami on 11 May 1981. Bob Marley's funeral was held in Jamaica in May 1981; thousands of people (come) to say farewell.



William Bradley Pitt was born in Shawnee, Oklahoma, on 18 December 1963 but (grow up) in Springfield, Missouri.

When he (be) at high school, he (do) lots of sports. He (start) to study journalism but in 1986 he (drop) out of university and (go) to Hollywood, where he (become) an actor.

He (start) with roles in TV series and then (move) on to movies. His first big film(be) *Thelma & Louise* in 1991. In 1995 he was nominated for an Oscar for his performance in the film, *Twelve Monkeys*.



Julia Fiona Roberts was born in Atlanta, Georgia, on 28 October 1967. She first (want) to be a veterinarian, but later (study) journalism.

She (become) an actress because her brother (start) acting. Her first success (be) in the film *Mystic Pizza* but she (become) really famous because of her performance in *Pretty Woman* in 1990.

She then (have) two years without much success, then in 1993 she (star) in a very successful film, *The Pelican Brief*. In 2000 she (win) the Oscar for Best Actress for her role in the movie *Erin Brockovich*.



Rudolf Khametovich Nureyev was born on 17 March 1938 on a train, near Irkutsk in the Soviet Union. As a child he (dance) in Bashkir folk performances.

After World War II, Nureyev (go) to the Kirov Ballet in Leningrad and within two years he (become) one of Russia's best-known dancers. In 1961 he (dance) for the Kirov in Paris. Audiences and critics (love) his performances, but he upset the authorities and they (want) to send him home, so he (leave) the country. He did not see Russia again until 1989. He (give) his last performance in 1992, in Paris, where he (die) a few months later, aged 54
